ReForest Now was registered with the Australian Government in January 2018. From then we began the hard work of establishing a Not for Profit with virtually no startup funds, seeking small grants and community donations.

25th January 2021: 60 rainforest trees planted at 475 Left Bank Rd, Mullumbimby, 2483.



Your first planting with us included Birdwing Butterfly vines. These are the only food source for the larvae of the endangered Richmond Birdwing Butterfly.

The planting in total consisted of 3200 trees over the new years week and was completed with over 100 volunteers.



Growing Birdwing vines to this stage takes years as they are a slow grower. They are being planted here in forest adjacent to the planting so that they can climb established trees.

15th February 2021: 2,713 rainforest trees planted at 194 St Helena Rd, McLeod's Shoot, Byron Bay, 2481.



(Above) ReForest Now crew planting your 2,713 trees at St Helena Rd. This property is the highest point in Byron Bay and is having 30,000 trees planted as a major seed source for local birds and the downhill flow of rainforest seeds to reclaim the valleys down to the Byron lighthouse. The planting is complete with loads of species that feed butterflies, moths, birds, insects and koalas.

(Left) Trees were planted big and strong, not the tiny stocks used in some projects. Some of your trees will be up to 2 meters tall by this time next year. We'll be posting content on that.
